



Citizen Dialogue

**Aim:** In the citizen dialogues we invited citizens to imagining the future of nanotech and sketch their own narratives of the future. These narratives were used in the dialogue to reflect on the needs, concerns and values that citizens have with respect to nanotechnology.

**Methods:** Prototyping, narrative writing, value clarification.

**Aim:** In the national stakeholder dialogues, participants explored current roles and interactions in the nanotechnology research and innovation system and identified which actions and interactions would be needed to better take societal perspectives into account.

**Methods:** Reflecting on citizen science fiction, playing a scenario exploration game, (inter)action mapping.
